The meaning of the ACCREDIA accreditation

All the calibrations proposed with the issue of an ACCREDIA Certificate are activities that we perform under accreditation, i.e. under the direct control of ACCREDIA.

They fall within the sectors, measurement ranges and CMC (i.e. the best measurement uncertainties that can be declared in case of an ideal instruments) specifically stated in our accreditation table (reported in the file "4 - Accreditation table" contained in this folder and always available in an updated form on the ACCREDIA website: www.accredia.it).

ACCREDIA is the unique Accreditation Body designated by the Italian government for all accreditation activities related to calibrations, testing, reference materials, quality systems etc, etc

The accreditation granted by ACCREDIA certifies the technical competence of our laboratory (Calibration Center LAT 067) to perform the calibrations listed in the accreditation table already mentioned.

In other words, it is ensured that the Calibration Center of LTF S.p.A. is constantly monitored by ACCREDIA which guarantees: the competence and impartiality of the laboratory staff, the correctness of the calibration procedures used, the suitability of the samples used for carrying out the measurements, the suitability of the environmental conditions of the laboratory and the correctness of the operational and management procedures aimed at guaranteeing the quality of the results with the final aim of ensuring the traceability of the measurements to the national and international standards of the International System of Units (SI).

ACCREDIA is a signatory of the International Mutual Recognition Agreements both at European level (EA - European co-operation for Accreditation) and at global level (ILAC - International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation) which means that the Certificates issued by the Calibration Center of LTF S.p.A. are accepted in hundreds of countries all around the world (practically in all industrialized countries).
